- ✓ Nomination is supported by your Council
- ✓ Completed application form submitted by 31th October 2017

Award Inclusion

- ✓ Framed Certificate
- ✓ Glass Award Trophy
- ✓ \$2,500 plus GST to be used for a professional development study tour (itinerary to be approved by LGFP Committee). The study tour can be interstate or international.

Award Conditions

- ✓ Award funds will only be released on approval of the itinerary by the LGFP Committee and provision of paid invoices for approved expense items
- ✓ The recipient will deliver a verbal report on the study tour at an LGFP event
- ✓ The recipient will indemnify the LGFP Committee and Members against any liability including injury, travel, loss of property or damages that may occur to the recipient or their possessions during an approved study tour
- ✓ The LGFP Committee decisions in relation to the successful recipient and the approved study tour elements are final and not subject to correspondence or review.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Nominations for the Finance Professional of the Year Award are open to any officer employed by a Queensland local government at the time of nomination in a finance related position.
 2. Committee Members of LGFP Queensland are ineligible for the Award.
 3. It is permissible, but not essential, to gain prior consent of the nominee for their nomination to be lodged.
 4. All nomination material submitted remains the property of LGFP Queensland. Applications will not be returned at the end of the Award period.
 5. All nomination information will be confidential and will only be available to the selection committee and award organisers.
 6. It is the right of LGFP Queensland not to make any Award if the applicants do not meet the selection criteria as specified or if the quality of nominees is not considered of a sufficiently high standard to warrant special recognition.
 7. In instances where the selection committee considers that the credentials of two nominees are identical, the President of LGFP Queensland shall make a determination regarding the successful nominee.
 8. The award includes bursary towards a professional development study tour valued at \$2,500 plus GST, recognition on an award trophy, recognition on the LGFP website and a framed award certificate. The successful applicant will be required to seek approval of the itinerary of the study tour prior to LGFP making payment.
 9. The winner of the Finance Professional of the Year "Dedication to Local Government and Council" Award will be announced at the LGFP Queensland annual conference.
 10. Applicants must agree to abide by the decision of the selection committee.
 11. The winner must provide a verbal report on the study tour to one of the LGFP events.
